Sobriety restrictions	FFS and MCOs do not have any sobriety restrictions.

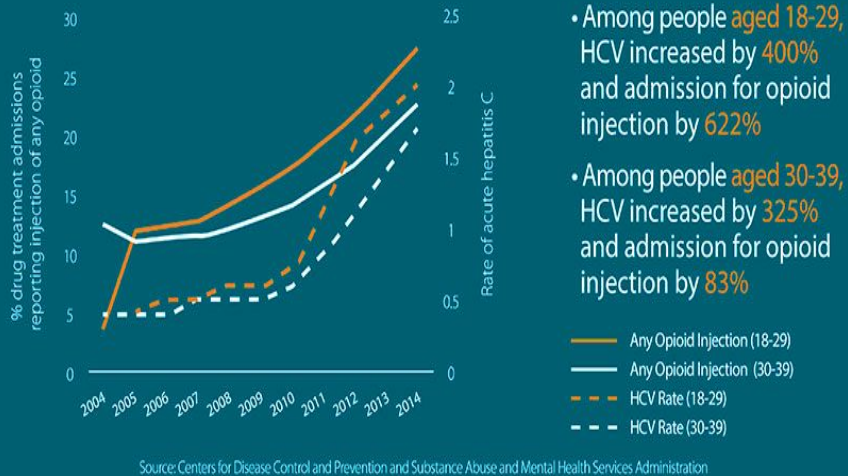
