HIV Alliance Overview

- **Care for over 1,000 people living with HIV in 13 counties**
- **Care for 75 people living with HCV in Lane County**
- **HIV, HCV, & STI Testing onsite and offsite.**
- **Education to almost 10,000 youth in 3 counties**
- **Outreach to over 3,000 high risk community members**
- **Syringe Exchange in Lane, Douglas, Curry and Josephine Counties**

Education Services

- Education to 10,000 youth in Lane, Marion, Douglas Counties per year
 - Youth in Treatment & Corrections receive 3 Presentations: HIV 101, Hepatitis C 101, & POZ speakers (people living with HIV sharing their personal stories)
- Education to over 1,500 Adults in Treatment per year
 - Both HIV and Hepatitis C 101
 - Linkage to testing
 - Emphasis of easy, free, confidential testing hours– empowerment to take “field trips” within groups.
 - On-site scheduled HIV/HCV testing events following education presentations

Hepatitis C Case Management

0.5 FTE Hepatitis C Case Manager: Karyn Gilbert, Leland Hilarides (Jan 2019)

Mission: Interrupt the spread of Hepatitis C through testing and educating those at risk of transmission.

Focuses on Injection Drug Users who participate in the Syringe Exchange Program, Persons who have previously been incarcerated, HIV positive individuals, and others at risk for infection per the CDC.

- Provides Care Coordination to **75 Clients**
- Referrals to **125 individuals**
- Hepatitis C Dinners, Bus Passes, Gas Cards, Food Boxes, Care Plans.



Syringe Exchange

- Provides new injection equipment including syringes, sharps containers, tourniquets, cottons etc. to over **3,000 individuals in rural counties** with over **7,000 exchanges** occurring in 2017.
- Provides information about detox, sexual assault services & safe injection.
- Emphasizes HIV/HCV testing and overdose prevention programs such as fentanyl testing stripes and Naloxone.
- Wound care doctors & HIV/HCV testing referrals

Cost of Syringe Exchange

- Cost of syringe: **\$0.08**
- Cost of sharps container: **\$1.22**
- Total NEX budget: **\$128,900** (\$70,628 supplies)
- Avg. per client annual cost: **\$37.39**

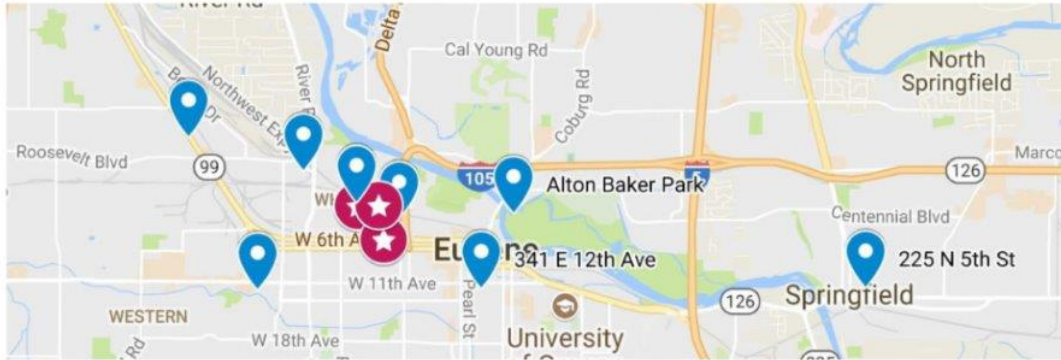
Cost of Care/Treatment

- Lifetime cost of HIV infection: **\$600,000**
- Cost of HCV treatment: **\$84,000 (varies)**
- **Estimated 75 new HIV infections annually without syringe exchange**
- **Testing linked to Hepatitis C treatment can save an estimated 320,000 lives nationwide.**

HIV Alliance collects on average 1,367 used syringes per day at exchange!

In 2017 our Drop Boxes collected 83,846 used syringes— that's 230 per day!

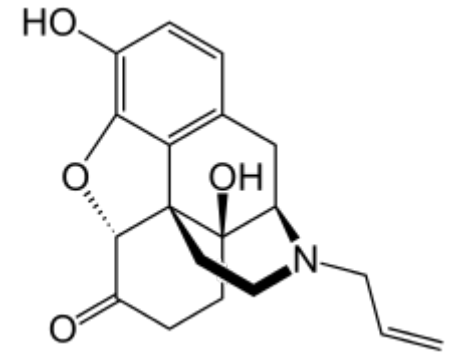

Naloxone Program

Since the beginning of our Naloxone program in January 2016, HIV Alliance has distributed nearly **5,000 Naloxone kits**.

- Trainings for needle exchange clients, friends and family of users, agencies, and the community.
- Since implementation **858 of those were refilled– 37% (312) were used to reverse an overdose.**
- Nearly **half (148) reversals were done within the last 3 months** as a response to fentanyl laced drugs in Lane Co.
- In response HIVA began its Fentanyl testing strips program.
