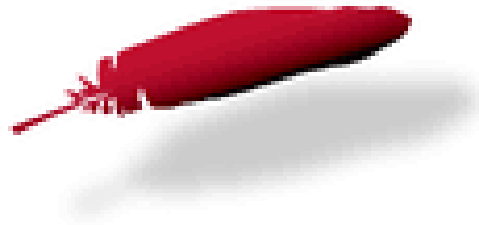

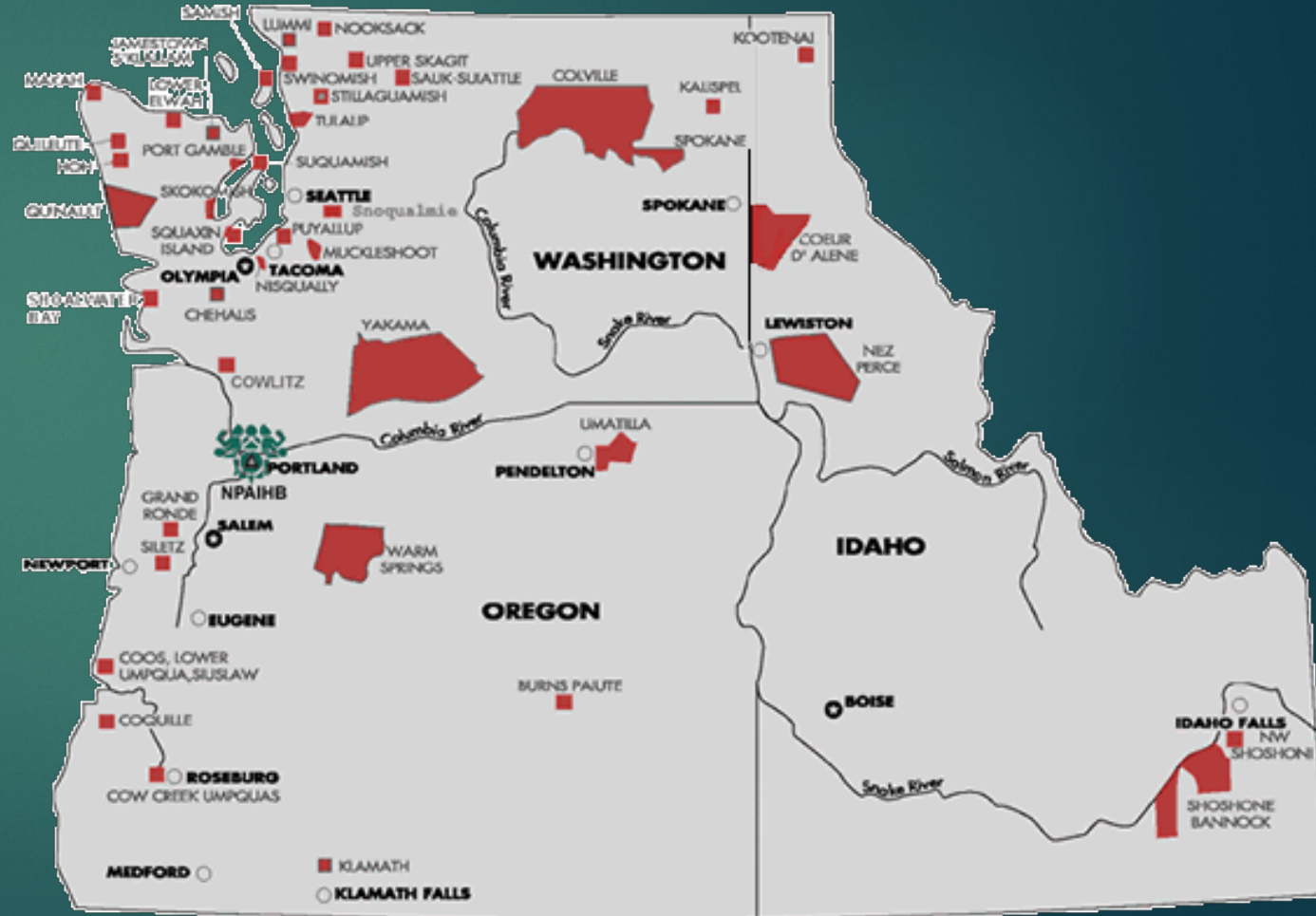

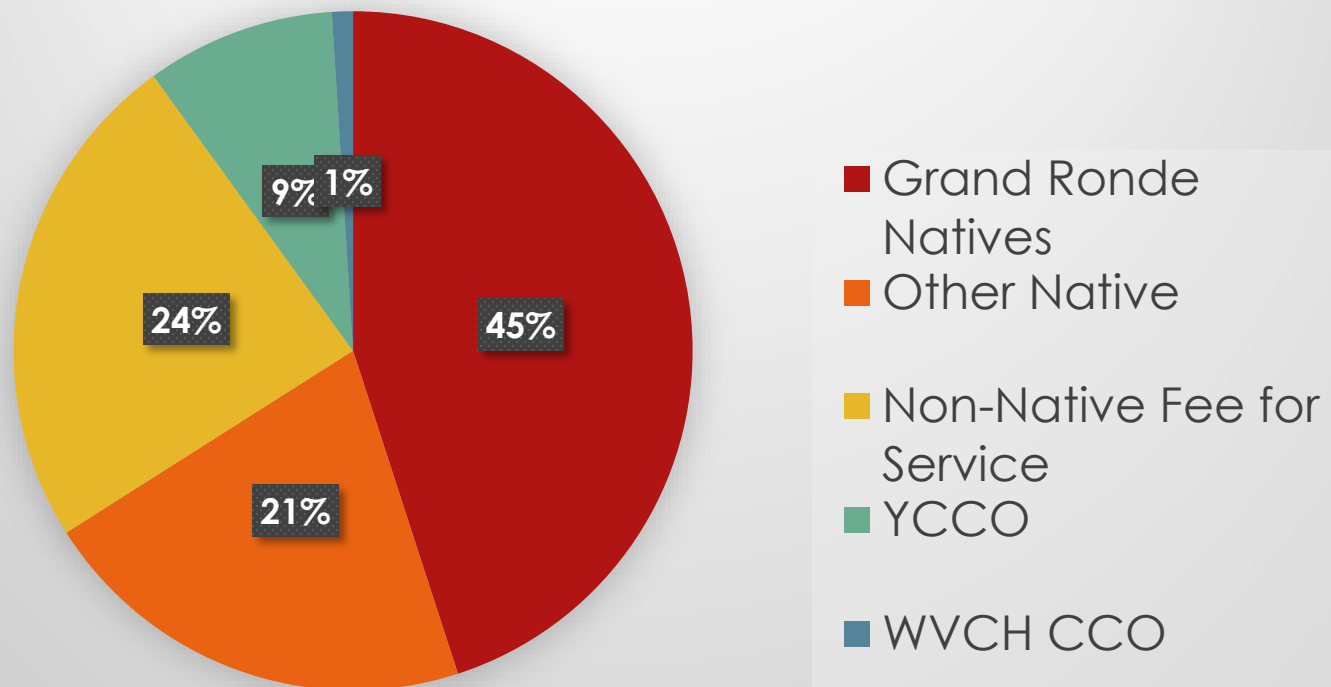
# Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board

## ▶ **October 2017**

- ▶ Prevalence 1 %
- ▶ Screening rate for baby boomers 14%

## ▶ **March 2018**

- ▶ Prevalence 2%
- ▶ Screening rate for baby boomers 37%

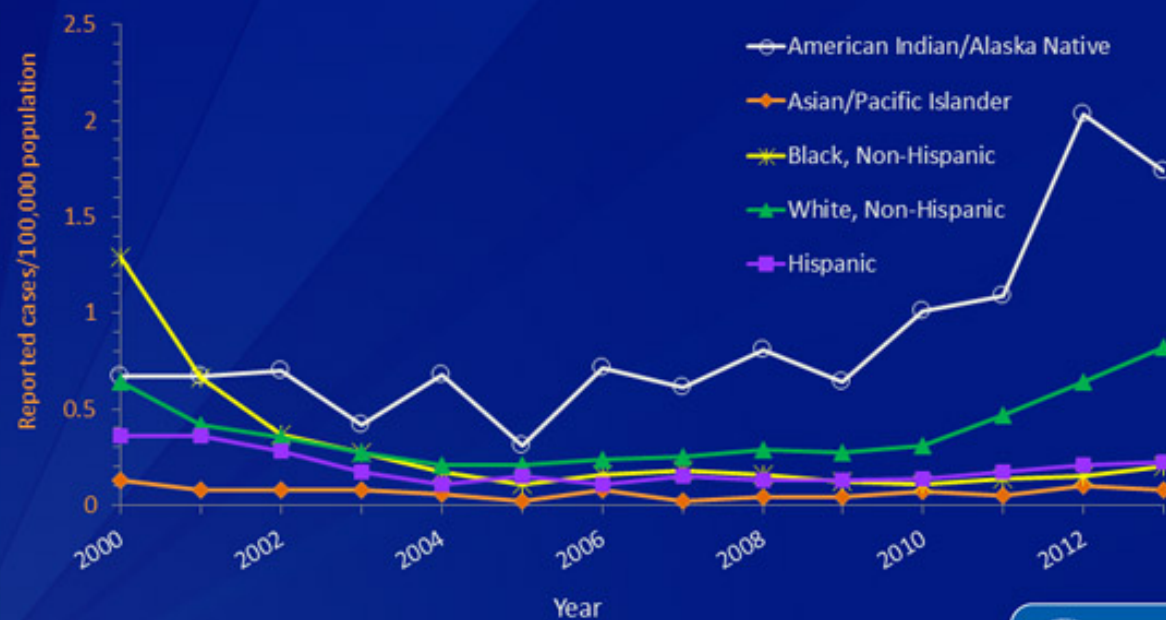

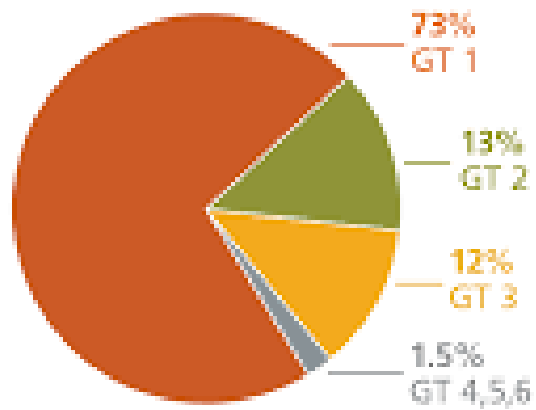

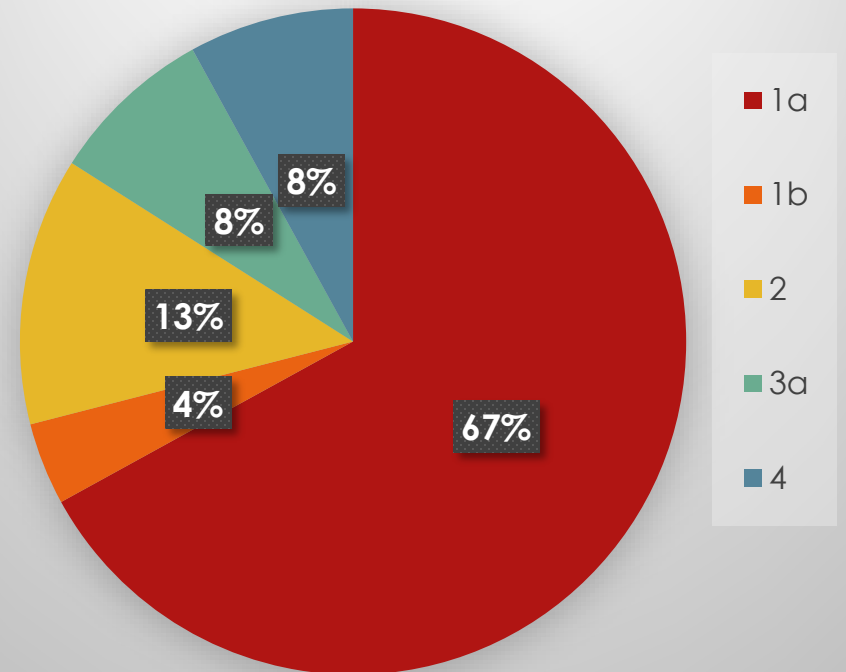
## US Distribution of HCV Genotypes

HCV genotypes 1, 2 and 3 are the most prevalent genotypes in the U.S., representing over 98% of all infections

## 36 patients were worked up for Hep C

- ▶ 5 patients are at SVR
- ▶ 5 patients completed treatment and are waiting for final labs
- ▶ 2 patients are currently in treatment
- ▶ 10 patients are waiting to start treatment
- ▶ 1 patient failed to complete treatment
- ▶ 2 patients were referred to GI
- ▶ 3 patients were not ready to pursue treatment

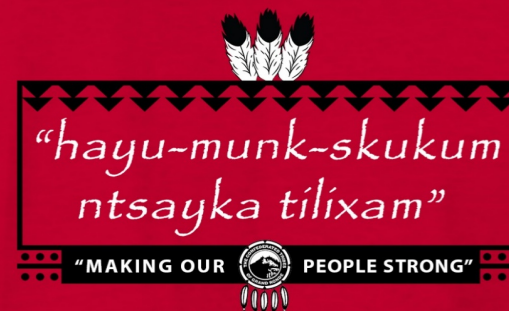
