


The Role of Reentry Service Providers in Hepatitis C Elimination


Exposure to hepatitis C virus (HCV) occurs through blood-to-blood contact with an HCV-positive person. Hepatitis C is VERY infectious and can live outside the body for up to several weeks.



States are exposed to HCV, and 12-35% have chronic infection.

About 30% of people living with HCV spend at least part of the year in prison
